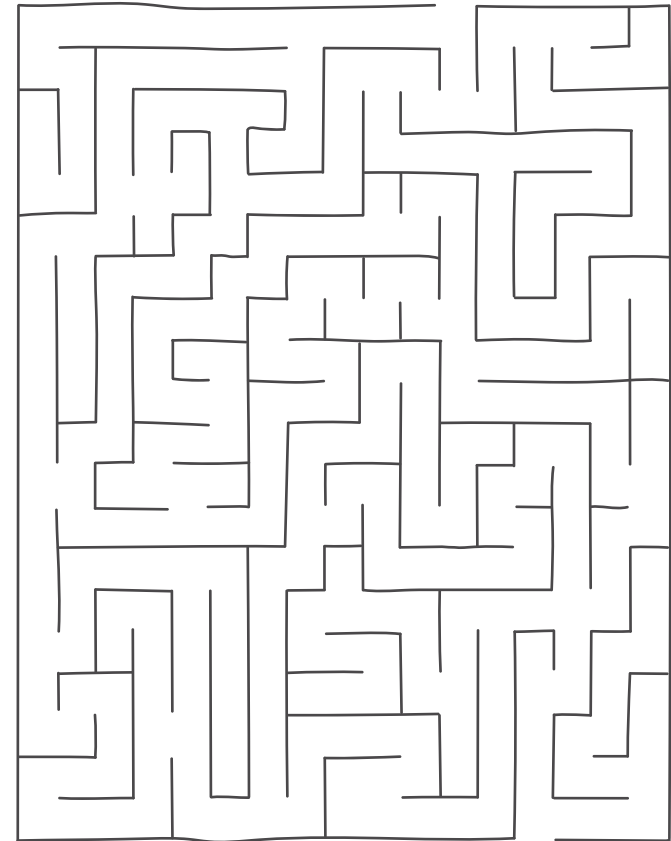
Artemis has got lost in the woods!

Help his eagle find it for him!





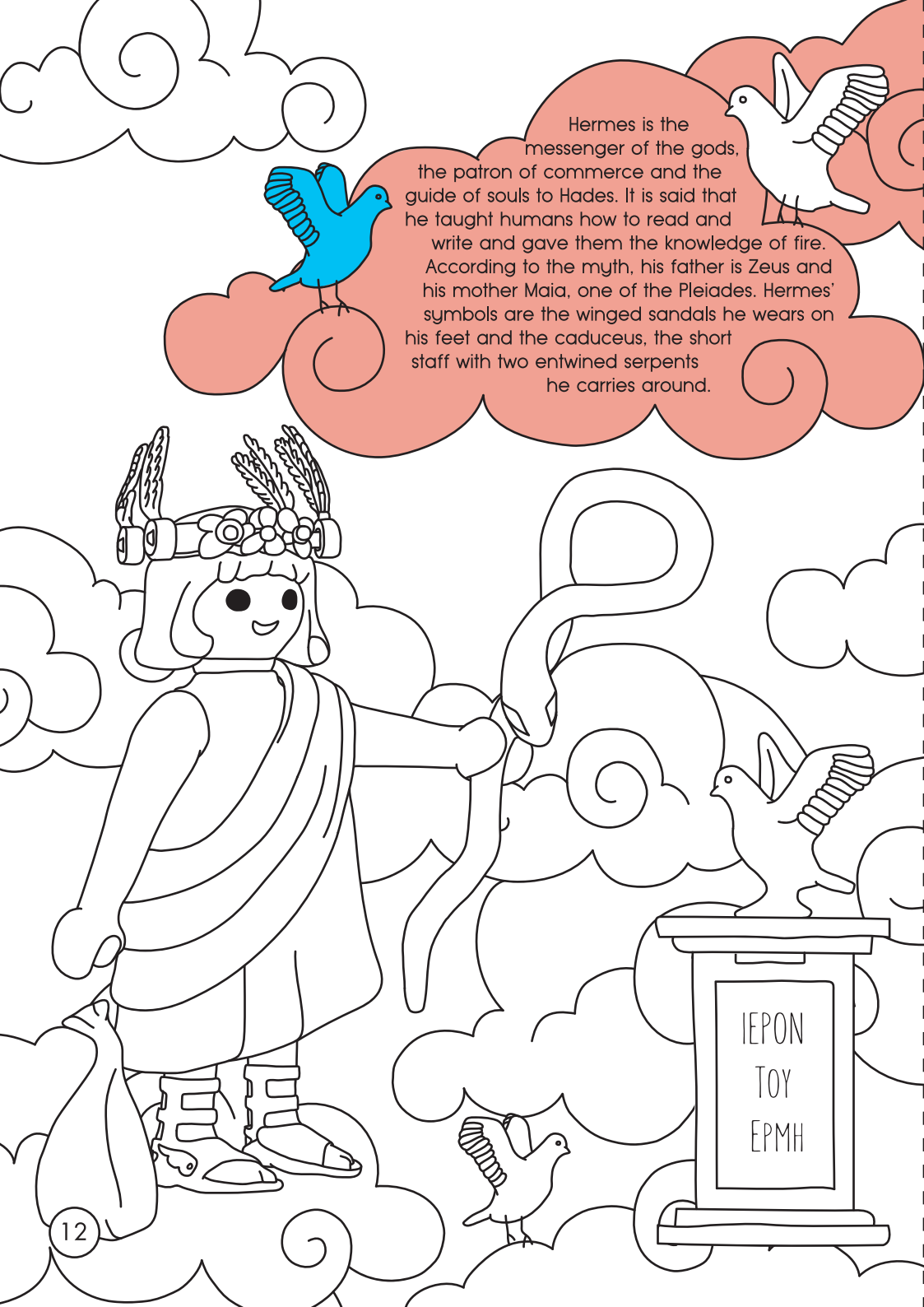

Help him get them back!

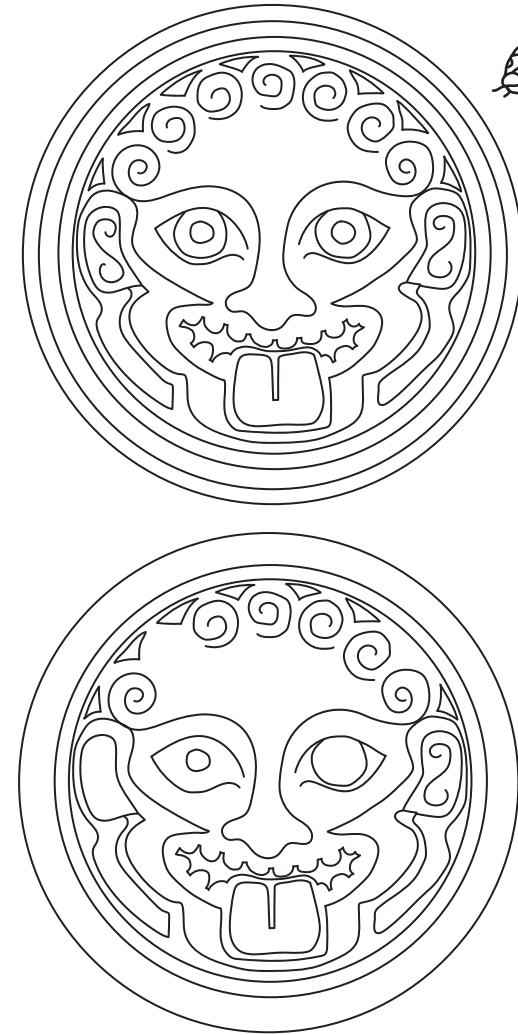
