Originally, the goat comes from wild goats from Asia Minor. The fur of the animals is white, black or brown.

Goats are active at dusk and feed on leaves or grasses. The wolf is one of their natural enemies.

A goat can live up to 15 years. When fully grown, it is 50 to 100 cm tall and weighs between 30 and 120 kg.

In biological terminology, the female goat is called goat, and the male goat is called he-goat.
