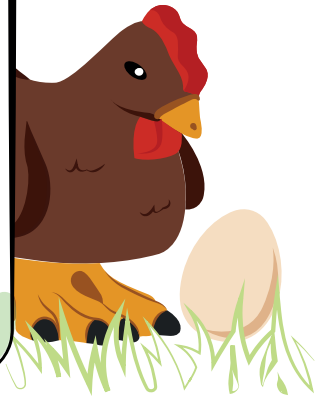

The chicken is a common farm animal all around the world. Originally, the bird comes from Southeast Asia and lives in forests and meadows. Their feathers can be white, black or brown.

The chicken is diurnal and prefers to eat insects, grains, grass or worms. Its natural enemies include foxes, crows, martens and many birds of prey.

A chicken can live up to 8 years. When fully grown, it is 30-40 cm tall and weighs between 1.5 and 5.5 kg.

The female chicken is called a "hen" and the male a "rooster". The peculiar head movements of the chickens help them to see better.
