## The new PALO series made of solid eucalyptus wood

### Care instructions

The planters from the PALO Natural Wood series are ready for outdoor use thanks to their pre-oiled surface. Wood is a natural product and is subject to natural changes in color and grain. In order to maintain long-term protection, we recommend regular care with suitable oil and / or wood preservatives, as well as storing the planters clean and dry in winter or when not in use.

### Step-by-step instructions for re-oiling:

#### 1. Cleaning the planter:

- First, clean the planter thoroughly with a soft brush and mild soapy water.
- Then rinse it with clean water and allow it to dry completely.
- Caution: Do not use a high-pressure cleaner, as this can damage the wood structure.

#### 2. Preparation of the surface:

- Lightly sand the surface of the wood with fine sandpaper to improve the absorption of the oil.
- Use a dust mask for larger surfaces and remove the sanding dust with a slightly damp cloth.

#### 3. Application of the oil:

- Choose a special oil for eucalyptus wood that matches the color pigmentation of the wood.
- Apply the oil generously to the wooden surface with a brush or alternatively with a cloth and spread it evenly.



#### 4. Remove excess oil:

- After approx. 15–25 minutes, wipe off the excess oil that has not been absorbed with a clean cloth to avoid sticky stains.
- For more intensive care, you can oil the wood several times, whereby the oil should dry for at least 24 hours before each new application.

#### 5. Drying time:

- After oiling, leave the planter to dry well protected from the weather for at least 48 hours before using it again.

Please observe the respective application instructions from the manufacturer of the care products used. The application and drying time may vary depending on the manufacturer.

#### Safety warning:

- Never leave oil-soaked cloths to dry crumpled up, as there is a risk of fire. Hang the cloths up to dry immediately after use, spread out and secure it with clothespins.
- Only use suitable oils and wood care products to avoid damaging the product.



**Note:**

Wood is a natural product that is significantly influenced by external factors such as temperature, UV radiation and humidity. We guarantee careful material selection for our products and high-quality workmanship of the planters and accessories. Nevertheless, changes can be observed in the material wood due to the above-mentioned weather influences. They do not constitute grounds for complaint.

You can counteract natural weathering processes, such as swelling, by treating the wood with high-quality wood care oils. However, the use of incorrect wood care products can damage the product in the long term. Damage to the product due to incorrect treatment of the wood is also not a reason for complaint.
